

ASPAC 2026: Digital Nursery Preparation Guidelines

Moving beyond traditional physical posters, ASPAC 2026 introduces the **Digital Nursery**—a dynamic space for digital exhibitions. This platform is designed for you to showcase pioneering projects, share visionary ideas, and pose thought-provoking questions that challenge our ASPAC network peers on how we can evolve our organizations for a better future.

All digital posters will be displayed on **high-resolution digital screens**. To ensure your work captures the audience's attention and displays flawlessly regardless of the final hardware setup, please prepare your files according to the following guidelines:

1. General Display Specifications (Applies to all formats)

- **Orientation & Aspect Ratio:** You may prepare your files in either a standard **16:9 (Landscape)** or **9:16 (Portrait)** aspect ratio.
(Note: The exact screen dimensions and final orientation will be confirmed closer to the event. We highly recommend keeping your core content and text within a "safe zone" away from the extreme edges to accommodate any display adjustments.)
- **Resolution:** Full HD (1920 x 1080 pixels / 1080 x 1920 pixels) or 4K resolution is highly recommended for maximum clarity.
- **High Contrast:** Use highly contrasting colors between text and the background for better readability on backlit digital screens.

2. Format-Specific Preparation

Please follow the specific instructions below based on your chosen submission format:

Option A: Static Digital Poster (PDF or JPG)

- **File Format:** .PDF or .JPG only.
- **File Size Limit:** Must not exceed 50 MB.
- **Design & Layout:** * **Visual-Driven:** Be creative and avoid text-heavy designs. Use visuals, diagrams, or infographics to tell your story rather than long paragraphs.
 - **Legibility:** Since the exact screen size is to be finalized, please ensure your text is large and legible enough to be read clearly from a viewing distance of at least **1.5 - 2 meters**.

Option B: Loop Video (MP4)

- **File Format:** .MP4 only.
- **Duration:** Maximum 2 minutes. The video should be designed to loop seamlessly.
- **Visual & Text Readability:** Even in video format, ensure any text on screen is large enough to read from a distance, following the legibility guidelines above.
- **File Submission:** Due to large file sizes, please provide a **cloud download link** (e.g., Google Drive, Dropbox, OneDrive) instead of attaching the file directly to your email. Ensure the link access is set to "Public" or "Anyone with the link".

3. Content Checklist & Best Practices

Despite the limited space or time, your submission must include these essential elements:

- **Title of Submission:** Make it clear, catchy, and relevant.

- **Presenter Information:** Please include your Name-Surname, Title/Position, Organization, and **Country**. This enables interested peers to easily identify your background and connect with you.
- **Thought-Provoking Questions / Core Idea:** Highlight the main issue or the specific question you want to pose to the ASPAC network.
- **Synopsis / Short Description:** A brief overview of your project or idea that can be easily digested within 1-2 minutes.
- **Call to Action & QR Code (Highly Recommended):** Add a QR code to your poster/video, allowing delegates to easily scan it to access full papers, download additional documents, or connect with you directly via LinkedIn or Email.

4. Submission Instructions
